The following list of wastes are not routinely accepted by Angelina County Waste Management Center.

1. Liquids

- 2. Sludge wastes including those from domestic septic tanks, POTW's, food processing plants, industrial waste water treatment plants, oil-water separators, vehicle facilities, etc.
- 3. Industrial Manufacturing Process Wastes including foundry sands, diatomaceous earth, filter cake, etc.
- 4. Solid residual or debris from clean-up of a spill of product.
- 5. Off-specification, contaminated spoiled, outdated or banned products and chemicals.
- 6. Ash from the incineration of municipal solid waste or medical waste.
- 7. Grease trap wastes from restaurants, hotels, etc.
- 8. Print shop waste.
- 9. Paint spray booth wastes.
- 10. Dry Cleaning Wastes such as spent filters.
- 11. Medical wastes from hospitals, medical practitioners, clinics, nursing homes, mortuaries, testing laboratories, veterinary clinics, etc.
- 12. Animal waste and grease from slaughterhouse and rendering plants.
- 13. Asbestos containing waste.
- 14. Demolition debris from decommissioned industrial facilities.
- 15. Chemical process or storage plant removed from service (e.g. storage tanks, reactors, pipe work, etc.)
- 16. Waste produced from vehicle maintenance facilities (e.g. used oil filters, oil containers not properly cleaned, liquids, etc.)
- 17. Landfill leachate and gas condensate removed from landfills.
- 18. Chemical-containing equipment removed from service including batteries, thermometers, fluorescent tubes, etc.
- 19. Chemical-fuel-or oil contaminated soils.
- 20. Empty chemical, paint or oil containers such as drums, pails, cans, etc.
- 21. Used tires.
- 22. Laboratory wastes.
- 23. TV's
- 24. Computers and monitors.

HAZARDOUS WASTE IS NOT ACCEPTED AT THIS LANDFILL
